


About University & History:	<p>Founded in the 16th century, it is the oldest university in Moravia and the second-oldest university in the Czech Republic. Its history goes back to December 22, 1573, when the former Jesuit College in Olomouc was given the right to confer degrees, i.e. promoted to university status. Almost 22 000 students are enrolled at its 8 faculties. The eight faculties of Palacký University ensure 237 Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctoral study programmes. The credit system at UP is fully compatible with ECTS – The European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System.</p>
