Why study M.P.H. at TUMS School of Public Health?

The history of the first professional program in the field of public health in Iran dates back to the establishment of Department of Parasitology within the School of Medicine at Tehran University in 1934.

The M.P.H. program is designed to provide an incredible opportunity for students to learn up-todate and fundamental skills in the core areas of Public Health, which are carefully tailored to meet the needs of individuals who are working, or planning to work, in the public health sector in the region and across the world.

Focus of the Course

The major and common characteristic of various disciplines of the M.P.H. program is to enhance participants' robust knowledge and competency in a wide range of practical skills. The entire program is a blended learning environment, with a fair combination of academic learning plus promotion of pragmatic skills.



Core Modules (15 credits)

Core courses are compulsory for all M.P.H. majors and must be taken during the first semester. They include: Principles of Epidemiology and Preparation of Research Grant Applications, Biostatistics and Applied Data Analysis, Public Health Nutrition, Health Systems, Environmental Health, Health Economics and International Health.

Major Courses (11 credits)

After completion of the core modules, students can select some elective modules that are matched with their areas of interest. This allows for a personalized, tailor-made academic program to fit students' individual needs and career goals. One of the major modules that will be offered during the 2019-2020 academic year is:

Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs): Epidemiology, Health Promotion and Life Style, Social Determinants of Health, Management and Planning of NCDs, Policy Analysis for NCDs and Surveillance of NCDs.

Complementary Modules (6 credits)

Complementary modules include an Internship (usually held during summer), plus the final project.

Eligibility Criteria

- Graduates of professional doctoral programs, i.e. Medicine, Dentistry, Veterinary Medicine, or Pharmacy;
- Graduates of Master's or equivalent degrees of health related programs;
- Fluency in English: Academic IELTS band score of 6 or its equivalent TOEFL iBT or PBT score;
- Work experience in the field of Public Health is preferred; and,
- Age up to 45.

Tuition Fees and Expenses
