All abstract presenters (presenting author) must be [registered for the congress](#) by September 1, 2017. Failure to register by September 1, 2017 will result in the abstract being rejected and the presenting author being disqualified to submit scientific content for **two years**. Please see the congress website for all policies and guidelines.

The poster surface area is 100cm horizontal wide by 200cm vertical tall (39 inches horizontal x 78 inches vertical). It is recommended that your poster size be 92cm wide x 120cm tall (36 inches x 48 inches) with final size determined by each author. Each poster must have a top label indicating the title of the paper and names of the authors. Additional [details on abstract poster guidelines](#) are available.

Abstract changes can be made now up until October 11, 2017, by logging in the author's online abstract submission account. Abstracts will be published in a supplement of [Sleep Medicine](#) and available online on December 2017.

Guidelines for Poster Presentation

1. The poster surface area is 1 meter (100cm or 39 inches) wide horizontal by 2 meter (200cm or 78 inches) tall vertical. It is recommended that your poster size be 92cm x 120cm (36 inches wide x 48 inches tall) with final size determined by each author.
2. Each poster must have a top label indicating the title of the paper, the names of the authors and their affiliations.
3. The size of the characters for the title should be large enough to be viewed at a distance of 2 meters.
4. Tape will be provided for you to affix your poster to the display boards.
5. You may hand out information sheets to those viewing your poster.
6. Charts, drawings, and illustrations may be used within the poster.
7. Posters should be printed on paper or laminated paper. Do not use heavy cardboard or other heavy materials for mounting.
8. "Introduction" and "Conclusion" sections are helpful. When feasible, use graphs for demonstrating qualitative relationships, tables of precise numerical values. Photographs should be printed on non-glossy matte finish paper.
9. Do not mail poster presentations to the convention center.
10. Do not fold your poster. Instead, transport the poster in an appropriate container.
11. World Sleep Society staff and/or volunteers will be present to assist you with locating poster boards and mounting.
