



Janice Palaganas, RN, MSN, PhD

Dr. Palaganas is an emergency nurse and nurse practitioner with two masters in nursing from the University of Pennsylvania and a doctorate of philosophy from Loma Linda University where she studied healthcare simulation as a platform for interprofessional education. She was the implementing director of accreditation and certification for the Society for Simulation in Healthcare and continues as a member of the Board of Review for the Council for Accreditation of Healthcare Programs. Dr. Palaganas has experience as faculty for schools of nursing, public health, business administration, emergency medicine and medicine. She has been involved nationally and internationally researching

healthcare simulation for interprofessional education and has been an invited speaker on topics related to interprofessional education, healthcare simulation, program development, patient safety, and accreditation.







Diana Tabak, MEd(S)

Diana Tabak has been a standardised patient educator at the University of Toronto for over twenty years, working closely with faculty in medicine, pharmacy, and other health professions in design and development of educational and training programs using clinical simulations. She has received teaching and educational development awards and has collaborated in a variety of teaching and educational research projects. She has consulted internationally on the design and development of SP programs and SP methodology at the University of the West Indies, Trinidad; the International Centre for Health Sciences, Manipal India; Charité Medical School, Berlin, Germany; Jordan University of Science and Technology and Amman University, Jordan and most recently as part of the Medical Advice, Quality and Absenteeism in Rural India (MAQARI), the Institute of Socio-Economic Research on Development and Democracy (ISERDD) in Delhi and other World Bank funded projects in Serbia.

Ms Tabak is a consultant to the Committee on Examinations – Family Medicine Simulated Office Orals (SOOs), College of Family Physicians of Canada, (2000-present). She is a member of The Family Violence Committee, Department of Family and Community Medicine, University of Toronto, 1998-present and the Association of Standardized Patient Educators (ASPE) 1999-present.
