**POSTER SIZE**

The board will be used **VERTICALLY**. Dimensions of the poster board are 7 feet high x 3 feet wide. These are the maximum dimensions to follow when creating your poster but you should make your poster smaller.

Presenters should bring their own adhesive for their poster. IADR suggests reusable command strips. Take into consideration the poster material and size when planning the amount of adhesive to bring.
