Please mount your poster on the board with the corresponding number. A numbered list of posters will be circulated in due course, along with the times of judging.

Poster presentations are on Thursday 23rd and Friday 24th November and poster judging will take place during the coffee and lunch breaks. The 20 highest ranked abstracts will be judged individually during the meeting with the opportunity to win prizes. Prize givings will take place on Friday 24th November at 17:05.

We look forward to seeing your presentation at the meeting. If you have not already done so, please make sure you pre-register for the meeting. You are entitled to the early bird rate which can be booked using the following link and password below.
