The scientific committee of the ESPU 30th ESPU Congress met on December 6th, 2018 in Leuven, Belgium.

This year we have received 551 abstracts/videos (474 clinical, 20 basic research, 57 videos). The scientific committee of 6 members has taken the decision based on an anonymous online abstract reviewing by 49 experts.

Scores ranged from 105 to 618 (except for videos and basic research abstracts which have a different scoring system), with a maximal possible score of 700. The overall acceptance rate this year is 40,11%.
