During this time members of the **UEG Week Faculty will be visiting your poster and interacting with you.**

In case you are not able to be next to your poster during this period, you are responsible that at least one of the co-authors replaces you. This poster presentation should be considered as important as an oral presentation!

POSTER CHAMP AWARD

UEG awards best posters on the basis of scientific merit using the evaluation process of the UEG Scientific Committee. The Award Ceremony will be held each day in the poster exhibition area. Prize winners will receive free entry to the Postgraduate Training Programme of the following year's UEG Week.

DISCLOSURE OF INTEREST:

UEG is committed to ensuring scientific rigour and objectivity in all of its educational activities. These include all aspects of the educational programme at UEG Week including those that are directly and jointly sponsored activities.

The UEG Scientific Committee requires all presenters to disclose any financial relationship with or any advisory role in the Biomedical Industry and the Biomedical Technology Industry during the past two years. These and any other potential conflicts of interest should be disclosed during introductory comments to the presentation. Invited speakers and oral abstract presenters are requested to disclose potential conflicts of interest on a PowerPoint slide to be shown immediately at the beginning of the presentation. **Poster presenters are requested to disclose potential conflicts of interest at the bottom of their poster.**

Conflicts of interest may exist through a financial relationship or when the individual has the opportunity to influence the content of a presentation, and can involve grants, honoraria, shares, paid positions on advisory boards, etc. Conflicts of interest are frequent and expected, and do not preclude an individual from giving a presentation providing the conflict is disclosed. If there is any doubt about the relevance of a potential conflict of interest UEG requires all presenters to err on the safe side and to disclose it.

PRESENTING AUTHOR:

Please keep in mind the Declaration you signed when submitting the abstract: "...Submission of an abstract constitutes a formal commitment by the author to present the abstract in the session and at the time decided upon by the UEG Scientific Committee. If the original presenting author is unable to present the abstract it is that person's responsibility to ensure that one of the co-authors take over this role. Failure to present the abstract, for other than well founded reasons, will lead to rejection of abstract submission at the next Congress."

If any changes in the presenting author occur, the presenting author needs to be updated by **Tuesday, July 19, 2016**.

TO CHANGE THE PRESENTING AUTHOR, PLEASE:

Write an email stating abstract number and title together with the new presenter to uegweek.abstract@ctimeetingtech.com.

Any changes received after **Tuesday, July 19, 2016** cannot be integrated in the Final Programme nor in the Abstract Book as online supplement to the UEG Journal.

WITHDRAWAL OF ABSTRACTS

If you need to withdraw your abstract, a written statement reflecting the reasons for this decision must be sent to uegweek.abstract@ctimeetingtech.com by **Tuesday, July 19, 2016**.

REGISTRATION:

Please note that you need to register to the congress in order to present your abstract.

As the author of an accepted abstract, you still have the possibility to register online with the reduced, EARLY registration fee.

The registration deadline for the EARLY registration fee is **Thursday, September 08, 2016**.
