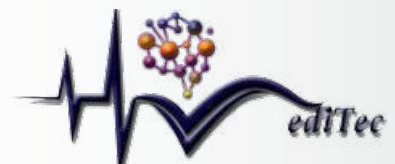

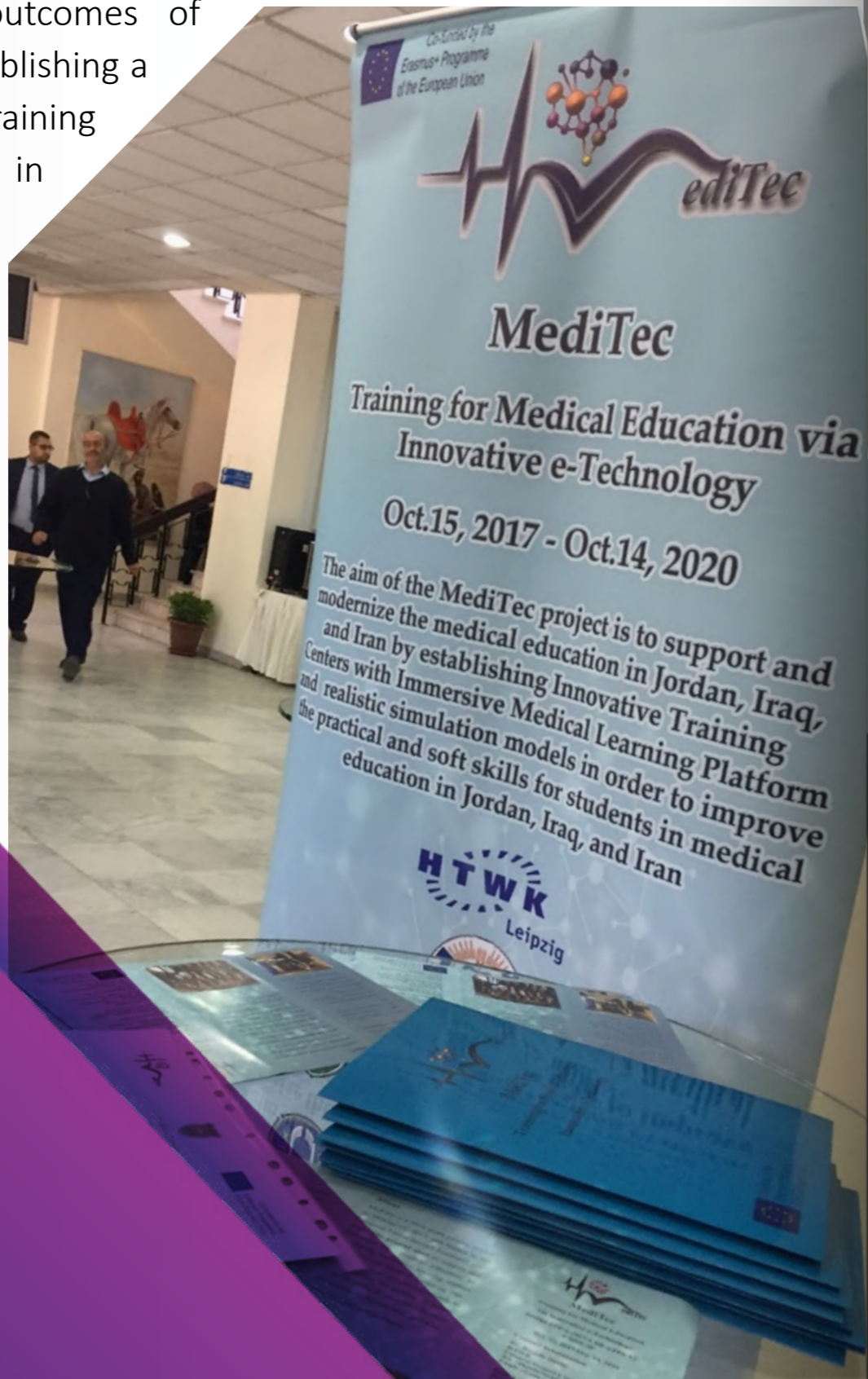

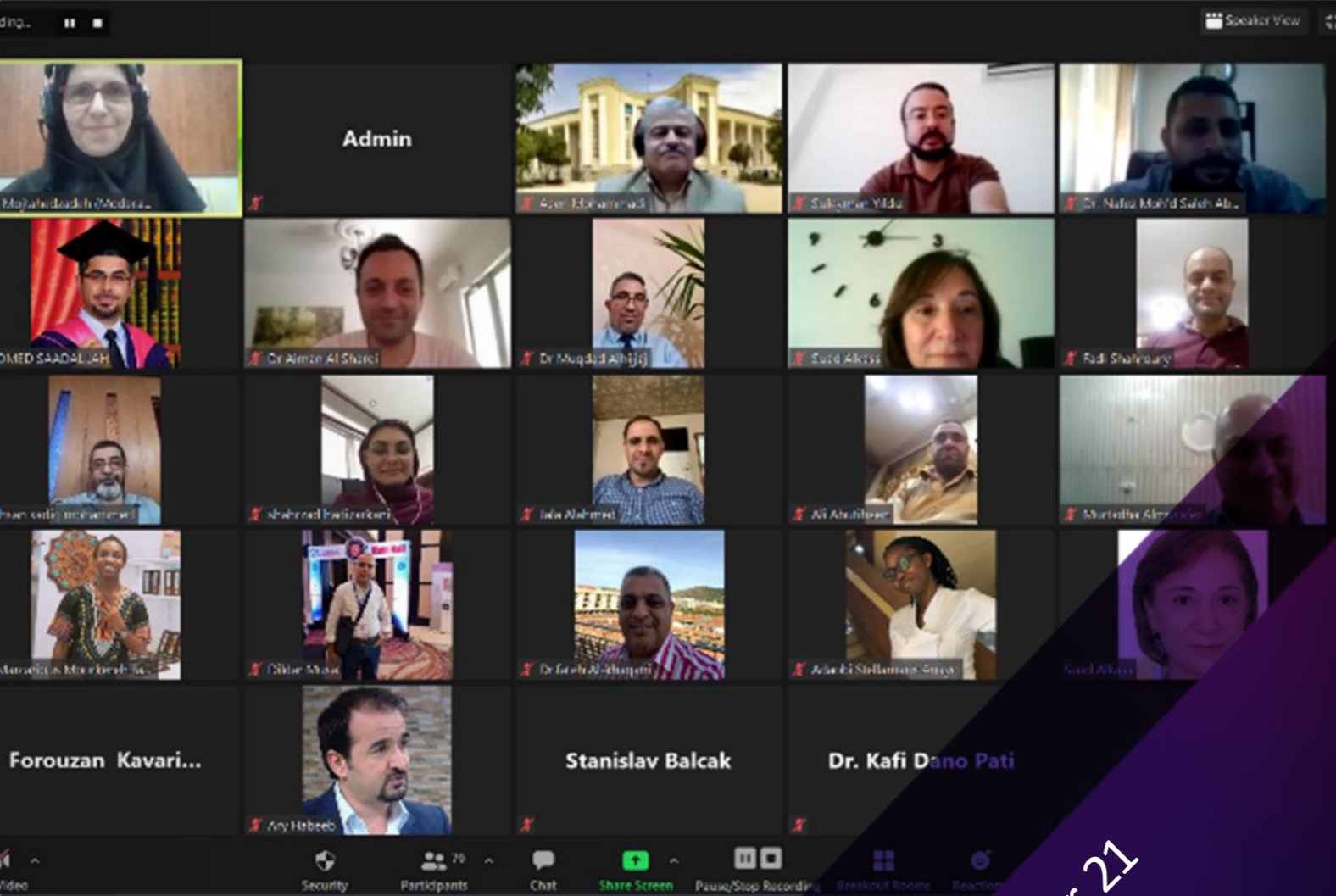

Symposium-Webinar on ‘Internationalization of Higher Education During Corona Virus Crisis’

A 3-day Symposium-Webinar on ‘Internationalization of Higher Education During Corona Virus Crisis’, which was planned on the initiative of the TUMS Directorate of International Relations, was held on May 18-20, 2020. The main purpose of this symposium-webinar was to address the most important educational issues resulted following the outbreak and spread of the Coronavirus.

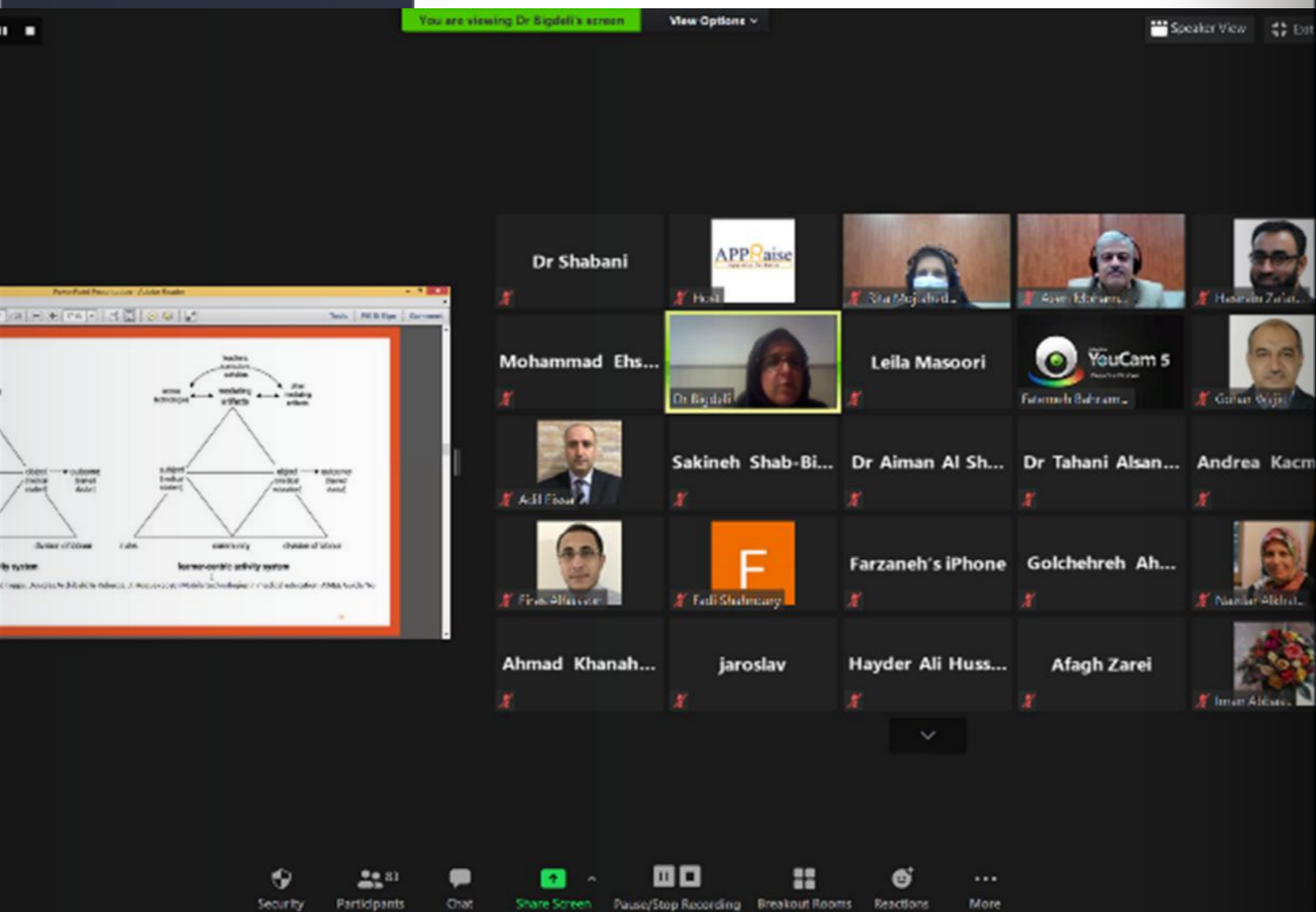




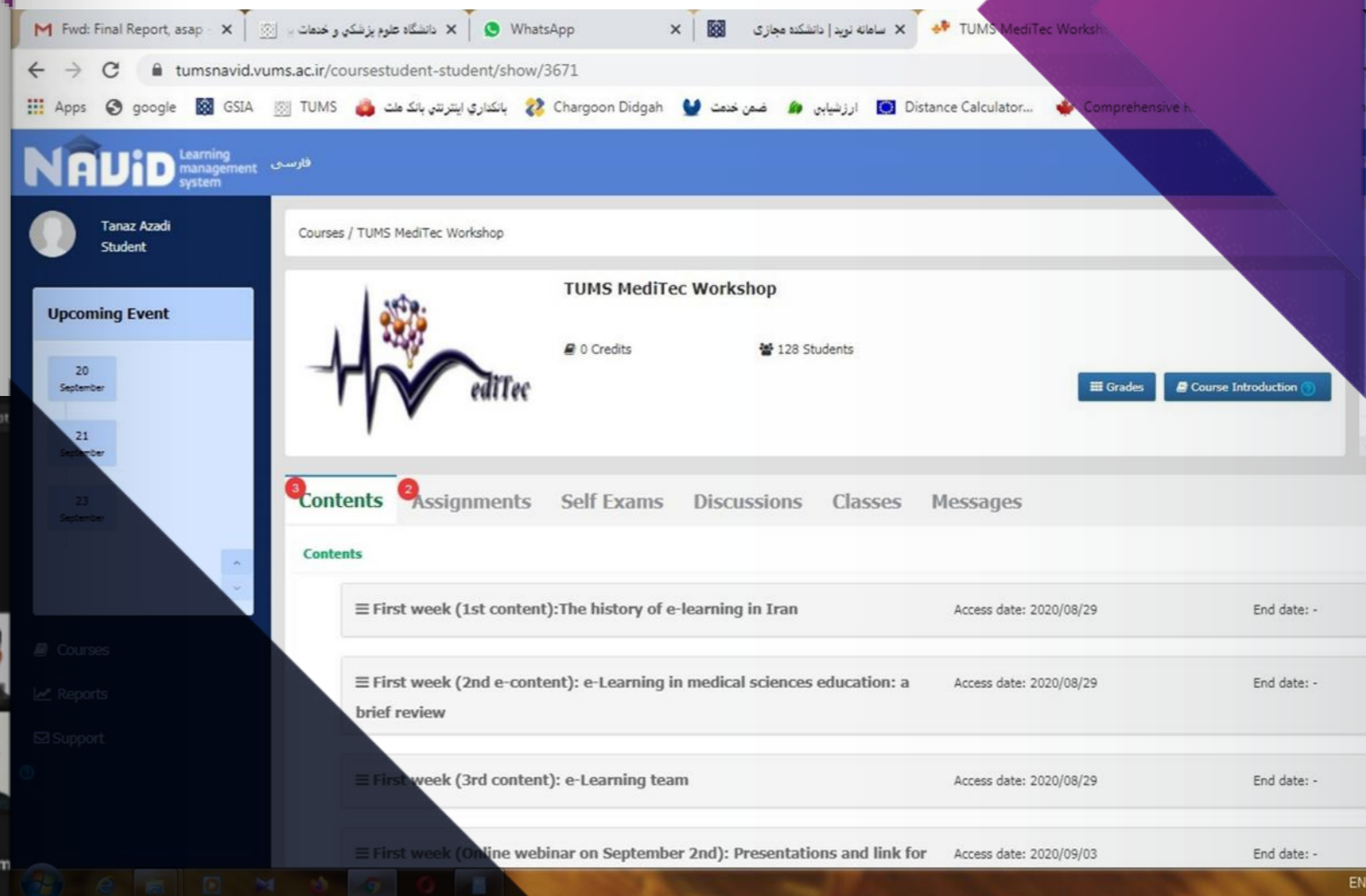
Dr. Mohammad Hossein Nekoofar, the TUMS Director of International Relations and Head of the symposium, announced the participation and cooperation of 33 world-renowned speakers from 25 universities and institutes of Iran and 15 countries who have scientific authority in the field of International Higher Education. The international speakers of this seminar were from Iran, Canada, Spain, Australia, the Czech Republic, Greece, Malaysia, Thailand, China, Finland, Germany, the United States, Hong Kong, Italy, Tanzania and the Netherlands.

During this symposium-webinar, MediTec project was introduced to the audience and they got familiar with the whole project via its website. It is worth mentioning that 1187 Participants from 54 Countries attended this webinar.

TUMS workshop on **“Emerging Technologies in Medical Education”** hosted by TUMS Virtual School was held from August 31 to September 21, 2020 via Zoom platform. European and non-European MediTec partners from Germany, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Malta, Jordan, Iran and Iraq attended this virtual event.



In addition to MediTec partners, this workshop hosted participants from India, Lebanon, Malaysia, Nigeria, Pakistan, and United Kingdom.

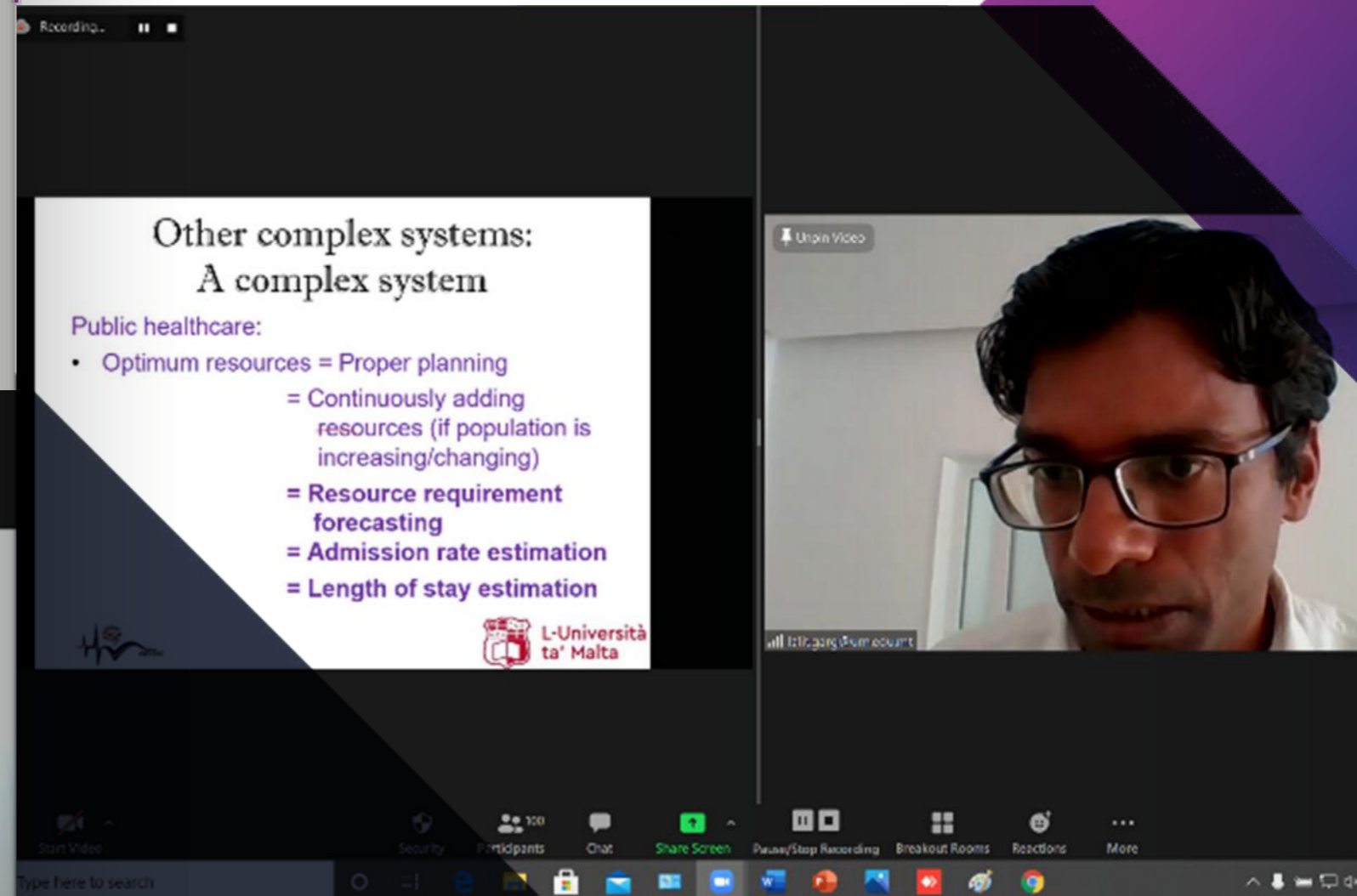


The workshop was included online webinar series and asynchronous courses at TUMS LMS, NAViD.

Two days before the workshop, participants received their usernames and passwords of TUMS' LMS. During the workshop, **16 lectures by national and international speakers** were presented and **three LMS activities** were performed. Participants, not only had access to the workshop study guide and useful introductory presentations, but also got familiar with **Iran** and **TUMS**.

During the workshop, related materials and slide presentations were uploaded in the LMS. In addition, there was the chance of participating in a forum for further discussion.

At the end, all participants received their certificate of attendance online. It is worth mentioning that **144 Persons** attended the workshop.



In August 11, 2020, JUST has organized a workshop for health care stakeholders in Jordan; under the framework of the Erasmus Co-funded projects (*MediTec and iBMS*).

Facial Masks with MediTec and Erasmus+ Logo

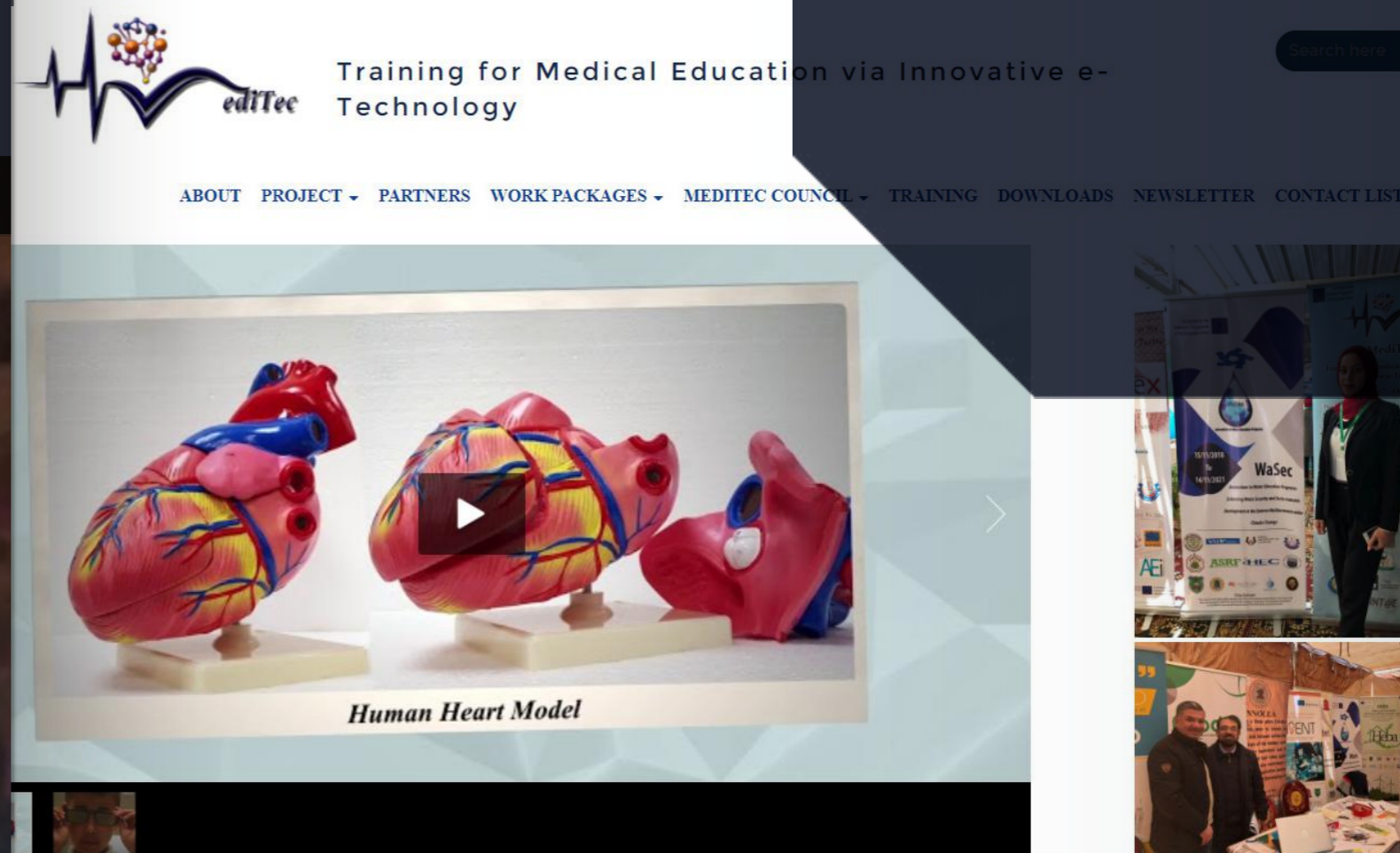
What could be more innovative to disseminate the project in public more than wearing a face mask holding the project logo in the COVID-19 crisis?
