

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into and executed on this 26th day of August, 2022 at New Delhi

BETWEEN

AND

Tehran University of Medical Sciences, Iran, through its President/Chancellor Prof. Hossein Ghanaati, (Hereinafter referred to as the 'TUMS'), which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the meaning or context thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns of the **SECOND PARTY**.

WHEREAS, Jamia Hamdard (JH) and Tehran University of Medical Sciences (TUMS) recognize their strengths in research and education in one or more disciplines of Medical, Pharmacy, Herbal/Unani Medicine (Traditional Medicine) and Allied Health Sciences, and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation.

JH and the TUMS referred to herein individually as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

- 1. JH and TUMS agree to establish a programme for academic cooperation in areas of mutual interest, and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum of understanding (MoU)JH and TUMS agreed herein as below:
 - a. That to exchange information on research and educational programmes,
 - b. That to exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes,
 - c. That to jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
 - d. That to jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
 - e. That to jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty and student to participate therein,
 - f. That to exchange, on a reciprocal basis, faculty and students for



- 2. That JH and TUMS agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above, if required, will be separately agreed upon by the two institutions by signing the implementing agreement for each activity. These terms shall include a description of proposed activity and financial arrangements.
 - a. That each Party will ensure appropriate protection of Intellectual PropertyRights generated from cooperation pursuant to MoU, consistent with their respective laws, rules and regulations and international agreements to which both parties are committed. In case of joint publication, the use of the name, logo and/or official emblem of the participants on any publication, document and/or paper will require prior permission of both the participants. Further, the Parties shall not assign any rights and obligations arising out of the IPR generated from inventions/activities carried out under the MoU to any third Party without consent of the other party. Commercialization of technology in any other country shall be done jointly through a separate agreement. All Confidential Information shall remain the exclusive property of the disclosing party.
- 3. That the parties of this MoU may, by mutual written consent, add, modify, amend or delete or any word, phrase, sentence or article in this MoU at any time during the operation of MoU.
- 4. That each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. The coordinator, thus appointed, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.
- 5. That This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for five years, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution three (03) months in advance. Once terminated, neither JH nor TUMS will be responsible for any losses, financial *or* otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, JH and TUMS will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.
- 6. In Case, there is any dispute regarding any matter arising from this



MoU relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Vice Chancellor, JH and Chancellor /President, TUMS will jointly and amicably resolve the dispute(s), (if any) in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.

7. Implementation of any of the terms agreed by JH or TUMS shall on prior intimation to the office of Scientific and Educational Affairs of the Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran, New Delhi and receiving his/her opinion, case to case basis.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have caused this MoU to be executed by the hands of duly authorised representatives on the day, month and year first before written and that the parties hereto caused this MoU to be executed by their duly authorised signatories in two original copies. The Parties mutually acknowledge and declare to have effectively negotiated and understand all the terms and conditions of this MoU and that; their concurrence on the MoU is the consequence of such negotiations and free will and without any misrepresentation, undue influence, coercion etc.
